




Impact of April Frost/Freeze on Grapes in Ohio

- Statewide frost/freeze
 events occurred on April
 21-22 and Apr 25-26
- 2021 March 12th warmest on record and driest in 150 years
- Budbreak 1-2 weeks earlier than normal
- Damage across grape growing regions: worst in Central, NW, and SE. In NE, worst damage (90-100%) in Concord; some damage (20-50%) in early budding vinifera
- Research vineyard,
 OARDC-Wooster: 29.5 F
 (22 Apr), minimum
 damage <1% (growth
 stage EL 3-7)
- Research vineyard, AARS-Kingsville: 27.3 F (26 Apr), no damage, no wind machine operation.
